

Caring for the Environment

We prioritize sustainability and environmental conservation. Our centre was built without disturbing the existing trees, and we use renewable energy sources including 164 solar panels and 3 micro-wind turbines. LED lights, timer switches for taps and lights and solar-powered LED street lights minimize our environmental impact. We encourage visitors to bring reusable bottles and cups to reduce single-use plastic waste.



Learning Rooms

Holt Room

Our main training hall, the Holt Room, is a multi-purpose space accommodating up to 50 individuals. The room can be arranged based on your training requirements and preferences. It features modern audio-visual systems, chairs, tables, mobile pin boards and whiteboards. Inspiring and thought-provoking posters enrich the training environment, promoting a positive mindset.

Saiq Room

Saiq can serve as a dining area for courses that require external food catering, providing a versatile space for nourishment and socializing. Hahn Room

Hahn room can be expanded into Saiq, allowing for additional seating of about 100 individuals.



The Hahn Room is a versatile training facility designed for smaller groups of up to 50 people. It is ideal for open discussions, small activities, and talks. Equipped with tables, chairs, a ceiling-mounted data projector and mobile pinboards and whiteboards this room offers a spectacular mountain view that serves as a great source of inspiration.



AV Room

The Audio-Visual room (AV) provides a superior theatre experience with high-quality audio-visual systems. The room can accommodate up to 80 people in a theatre-style seating arrangement. It is perfect for seminars, speeches, events, and presentations.

Outdoor Shaded Areas

Amphitheatre

An open outdoor theatre seating up to 50 people.

Al Arish

A palm hut that blends with the natural scenery, creating a tranquil space for rich discussions and providing shade for up to 20 people.

Outdoor Display Area

Offers shade for a group of 45 and serves as a discussion area. It also contains three informative display boards sponsored by bp Oman to advocate for renewable energy, biodiversity, and climate change challenges and solutions.

Rooftop Solar Panel Shade Provides shade for up to 100 people and allowing them to enjoy a meal under the shade of solar panels while taking in the breathtaking view of the centre and surrounding mountains.

Both are supported by solar panels, serving dual purposes of shade and renewable energy generation:









Male Wing

- **Pomegranate:** Instructors' Rooms with a bunk bed, toilet, and mini-fridge
- But: 10 beds
- Damask Rose: 10 bed
- Wash room: equipped with prayer faucets, sinks, showers, stalls, and toilets.

Female Wing

- **AI Rus:** Instructors' Rooms with a bunk bed, toilet, and mini fridge)
- Wild Olive: 10 beds
- Juniper: 10 beds
- Wash room: equipped with prayer faucets, sinks, showers, and toilets.

Dividers between the wings

Ensuring privacy and convenience.

Our centre offers comfortable accommodation for up to 60 individuals in simple alpine sleeping platforms.



Two Large Rooms

Al Ayn and Wadi Bani Habeeb:

Each room accommodates 12 individuals, featuring bunk beds, a lounge area, and a pantry.

Climbing Area

Experience the thrill of our climbing area that features activities such as the climbing wall, Leap of Faith, spider web and challenge wall. These activities unlock human potential, foster teamwork, and develop a whole range of soft skills.



Safety Procedures

We prioritize your safety and have implemented various measures:

- Safety emergency exits are clearly displayed in every room.
- Fire alarms and sensors are installed throughout the centre, detecting both smoke and smells.
- In the event of an electricity shortage, a generator ensures an uninterrupted power supply.

While being at a high altitude may result in weak service, our centre has WiFi available. Omantel carrier works best for connectivity.
