LOOKING FOR A GRANT?

- Most CVS have a development worker(s)
- Usually part of their role is to advise on funding
- This might be using a funding tool to look for a suitable grant
- It could be administering their own grant scheme
- Or, reading over and commenting on draft applications



DERBYSHIRE DALES GRANTS

- Better Derbyshire Dales Fund
- Living Well
- Cost of Living Fund
- UKSPF

BETTER DERBYSHIRE DALES FUND

- Small grants for voluntary and community organisations
- Grants up to £5,000 capital and £1,000 revenue
- Quarterly rounds
- For organisations with an annual income of less than 75,000 p.a.





Cost of Living Fund

- Most Derbyshire CVS have administered this fund, from DCC Public Health
- DDCVS has a small amount remaining
- to support groups with anything relating to the increase in cost of living but particularly interested in supporting people very much affected by rising costs
- we have awarded a variety of grants including
 - hot meal for community group
 - take away cartons so that members can have a hot evening meal

LIVING WELL

Grants up to £1,000 for: -
room hire, equipment, resources, items
needed.

Not included: -
Worker time, travel expenses, food or
training

We want to hear ideas on developing an
existing group, perhaps attracting 'new'
people that are currently not linked to other
groups to support positive mental wellbeing.

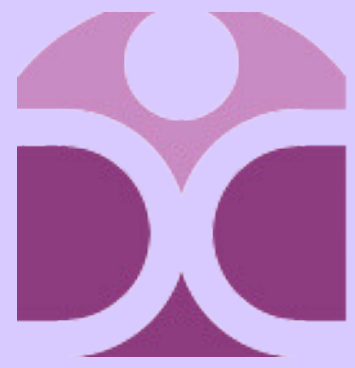
